

The Scholarship Offer

1. £22K tax-free bursary during your initial teacher training (ITT) year
2. Following your ITT, teachers will receive two additional early-career payments of £5,000 each (£7,500 if teaching in local authority areas where teachers are most needed) in their third and fifth year of teaching, if they have taught in a state-funded school in England since completing their teacher training course. The amount is after tax, so teachers will receive the full amount as stated.
