Information to reach Nancy

1-Travelling by plane

- **Paris Charles de Gaulle (CDG)**
- **Paris Orly (ORY)**
- **Luxembourg Airport (LUX)**
- **Strasbourg Airport (SXB)**

2-Then, take a train (Go to [SNCF-connect](#) to purchase the train tickets).

- From **Paris center**: take a TGV (high-speed train) from Gare de l'Est to Nancy (around 1 hour and 30').
- From **Paris CDG airport**: there is a direct TGV train from the Paris CDG to Nancy, stopping at Lorraine TGV train station and connecting to Nancy centre via a 30-minute shuttle bus. In the SNCF app you can directly indicated the departure from the CDG airport and the destination of Nancy and the app will propose you the solutions available (normally 1 train up to Lorraine TGV and then the shuttle bus). In alternative, take the RER B to Paris center and take a TGV from Gare de l'Est to Nancy.
- From **Luxembourg airport (LUX)**: take an available bus outside the airport up to the Luxembourg train station and then take a regional train up to Nancy station (1 hour and 30').
- From **Strasbourg airport (SXB)**: take 2 trains, the first from the airport to the Strasbourg train station, the second from Strasbourg train station to Nancy train station (around 2 hours). In the app you can directly indicated the departure from the SXB airport and the destination of Nancy and the app will propose you the solutions available (normally 2 trains).
